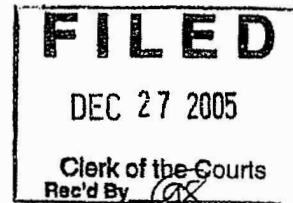

ORDER

The Applicant/Defendant, MasterCard International, Inc., has filed a Rule 9 application in which it requests that this Court grant it permission to appeal interlocutory orders of the trial court.
